The story is narrated by a boy named Oliver. Ivy is his little sister. Monkey is Oliver's toy teddy. Monkey will be feature on each page throughout the book for readers to spot – much the same as the ball was bouncing through Zoo Ball.

Instructions:

- Each page spread will be square.
- What you put on each page is up to you! You can imagine what might happen from the story.
- Children can choose any page and illustrate it. Some pages are single and others are meant as a double page illustration.
- Think about where the text might fit on the page. We will place the text to suit the picture, but consider where it might need to be when creating your page.
 - If a child chooses a simple page illustration the size required is 21cm by 21cm. This can be cut from an A4 page.
 - If you choose a double spread the size is 42cm long by 21cm high. You will need to either use an A3 sheet of paper or art paper.
- Art paper should be used where possible
- Scans need to be high resolution (minimum 600).
- You must keep the original artwork should we need a further scan.
- To enter fill in the form online and attach your image.
- After you complete the online form you will receive an automatic email to know it has been received. Before any entry is made public if you are shortlisted you will be sent a form for your parent's signature to approve use of your images.
