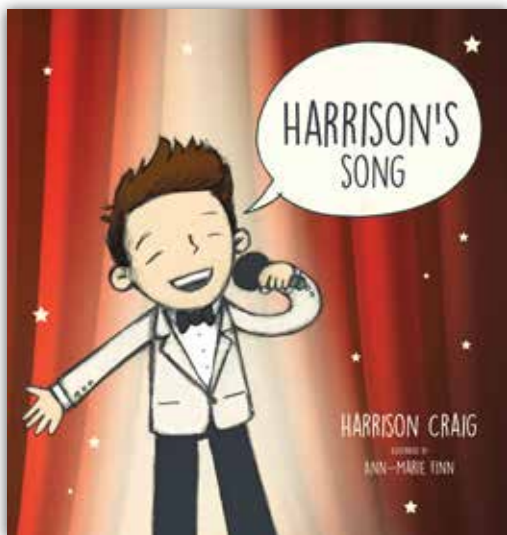
“Being a kid is tough and overcoming challenges can be hard, but when you find what makes you special, you can do almost anything.”
